Lower Key Stage Two

When children have finished Key Stage One (years 1-2) they move into Key Stage Two (years 3-6).

- Lower Key Stage Two consists of Year 3 and Year 4.
- There are two classes in each year group. Class sizes are a maximum of thirty children. Each class consists of one teacher and at least one teaching assistant to support the needs of the children.
- In both year groups children are registered in their own classes and may be taught as a class or mixed across their year group or phase for different subjects. This is dependent on the needs of the children.

There is a small shared area in the Lower Key Stage Two area that the children access as needed. The children work together (years 3 and 4) on a range of events.
