

Upper Key Stage Two

When children have finished Lower Key Stage Two (years 3-4) they move into Upper Key Stage Two (years 5-6).

- Upper Key Stage Two consists of Year 5 and Year 6.
- There are two classes in each year group. Class sizes are a maximum of thirty children. Each class consists of one teacher and at least one teaching assistant.
- In both year groups children are registered in their own classes and may be taught as a class or mixed across their year group or phase for different subjects. This is dependent on the needs of the children.
- When children move into Upper Key Stage Two they take on more whole school responsibilities such as:
 - Dinner time helpers
 - Play leaders
 - Reception buddies
 - Prefects
 - Head and deputy head boy and girl
 - Pupil Senior Leadership Team
