4, Our outcome will be...

To investigate life in the Stone Age and the transition between Bronze Age and Iron Age. To combat the ongoing cost of living crisis.

2, We have had an exciting half term exploring the Stone Age. We started our learning off with our Stone Age Day where the children showed a deep commitment to their learning and an enthusiasm for their topic. We really enjoyed making Stone Age artefacts and meeting an archaeologist. The children have also been developing their French understanding and vocabulary through MFL lessons, and their use of engraving and printing Celtic patterns has produced some beautiful artwork for our classroom. In Art and in other subjects like PE, Topic and PSHEE the children have displayed their observation and personable skills through team work, evaluations and creations of work. We are really proud of their progress.

In History and Geography we will be developing our knowledge of the Stone Age and the transition through the Bronze and the Iron Age. During STEM Fortnight, we will be combining alots of our curriculum learning to combat the cost of living crisis. We will be creating an indoor allotment and visiting Claver Hill to research how and what we can do to achieve this. Our Science and DT learning will lead this learning experience. In Maths, we are applying our current knowledge in STEM Fortnight, as well as using statistics and length and perimeter. In Literacy we will be creating documentaries using play scripts and writing newspaper articles linked to our Music sessions with More Music. In RE, we are learning all about Christianity—Church. In PSHEE, we will be looking at what makes relationships healthy and how to be a good friend, as well as how to manage our emotions and have a healthy wellbeing. In PE, we will be creating games to test our fundamental movement skills as well as honing our orienteering skills. In Computing, we will be learning how to use Purple Mash for Statistics. In MFL we will continue with our learnt skills, as well as familiarising ourselves with traditional tales.
