Dear Year 5 Parents,

We are excited to be taking the Year 5 children on a trip to the Fylde Coast.

The children will visit various points along the Fylde Coast including Lytham, Blackpool and Fleetwood. This trip links in with our Geography topic of Coastlines where we look at the impact of natural and human activities on the changing coastline.

The cost of the coach is £10.00 per child. To be able to go on the trip we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.00. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead. However, if your child is either on free school meals, an armed forces service child or a looked after child school will pay for this trip from the ppg budget unless you are willing and able to meet this contribution...please see ppg statement on the website <https://www.bowerham.lancs.sch.uk/our-pupil-premium/>. For PPG children- please confirm in child's communication diary if you wish school to pay this as this will also act as permission for them to attend the trip.

We completely understand that this may be a large cost to pay in one sum so we would like to offer the option of paying for the trip as a reducing balance. If you have any difficulties meeting the payment deadline then please do not hesitate to contact us for support.

The total balance needs to be paid by the **17/03/23**. You can pay as little or as much as you wish on the Parent Pay balance up until this date.
