Drawing London Landmarks Water colours – Silhouettes of London Landmarks Painting of London Landmarks (Acrylic paints) GEOGRAPHY: London's Burning Great Fire of London Changes The UK and weather patterns Children will study the events of 1666, and how these impacted our capital city including how the weather conditions carried the fire; they will use maps to locate England, London and other major cities, countries and the surrounding seas of the UK, and identify geographical characteristics of the four countries and capital cities. They will build on this with observations of daily and seasonal weather patterns in the UK. Seasons and weather. HISTORY: London's Burning Chronological order of events – The Great Fire of London DT: Christmas Makes including Christmas (Lancaster landmarks calendar) and calendar (Elf card with a lever mechanism)	ART: Printing and rubbings: Weaving: Mother's Day Cards Plasticine, print making or everyday print making (exploring patterns, lines etc) GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY: Lancaster THEN and NOW Our School – fieldwork skills Children will study the school grounds, exploring the environment by following maps and will begin to use a compass and compass directions. Children will observe human and geographical features, locating them on maps and ariel photographs. Children will begin to devise simple maps; and use and construct basic symbols in a key. Children begin to understand that places can change over time through exploring changes within the school grounds. Children will look at changes they recognise in and around Lancaster, and discuss recent national changes, for example, the change of monarch.	ART: Chas Jacobs: Hot air balloon collage.
