

We are pleased to inform you that our Year 6 class has once again been offered the opportunity to take part in the 'Be the Change' project — a fantastic, hands-on learning experience focused on **Democracy and British Values**.

This engaging session, held at Lancaster University, provides pupils with the chance to explore key concepts through interactive activities. It serves as an excellent starting point for further learning in school and is always a highlight for the children.

Trip Details:

Project: Be the Change: Democracy and British Values

Date: Thursday, 22nd May 2025

Start Time: 10:00am **Finish Time:** 2:00pm

Transport: Children will travel by coach, leaving school at 9:30am and returning by 2:30pm.

The session itself is **free of charge**, but there is a **transport cost of £4.60 per child**, which is payable via **ParentPay**. However, if your child is either on free school meals, an armed forces service child or a looked after child school will pay for this trip from the PPG budget unless you are willing and able to meet this contribution. For PPG children, please confirm in your child's communication diary if you wish school to pay for this, as this will also act as permission for them to attend the trip.

Children should come dressed in **full school uniform**, and bring a **packed lunch** and a **water bottle** with them. If your child is on free school meals, school will provide a packed lunch for this trip. Please write in your child's communication diary if you will be providing a packed lunch from home on his day.

We are confident your child will find the session both enjoyable and enriching, and we look forward to seeing the positive impact it will have on their understanding of democracy and citizenship.
