- For health and safety reasons, prams cannot be taken into the hall, but you're welcome to leave them just outside the hall or under the canopy at the front of the Nursery building.

Uniform

- This helps keep everyone safe, cool, and happy while enjoying the sunshine!

Important: Bag Sizes from September

Starting in September, all children will need to bring a bag that fits inside their tray — ideally a **drawstring bag** or a **book bag**.

Please avoid rucksacks, as they are too large and take up too much space in classrooms.

We're making this change because bulky bags with unnecessary items have caused storage and congestion issues. Children only need to bring their **communication diary**, **water bottle**, and in winter, maybe a **hat**, **gloves**, **and scarf**.

We understand drawstring bags may not be as comfy as rucksacks, so if you prefer, a **small/mini rucksack that fits in the tray space is fine**.

We're also committed to **poverty-proofing**, and we encourage families to stick with book bags, drawstring bags, or small rucksacks as children move up the school. This keeps things consistent and helps avoid the need for new or branded bags each year.
