BOWERHAM SCHOOL FOUNDATION - SUMMER 25 UPDATE

As the school year draws closer, we wanted to let you know what's happened since we launched our charity to support the school and say a big thank you for all your support.



Money Raised

Since launching the charity, the amount generated to support the school's pastoral team's activities has **quadrupled!** Some of this is from direct donations to the charity: both one-off gifts and regular commitments. We have reclaimed over £300 from HMRC as GiftAid - money that we couldn't previously claim back from donations. The rest is from Easyfundraising. We now have 77 supporters registered: between them they have generated over £260 of donations from shopping they were doing online anyway.

Money Spent

We have paid for £70 of the food used at the school free-to-use breakfast club - this is about the cost for each half term. £150 has been transferred for Autumn term, with the same sum identified from current funds to cover the remainder of the next school year. £350 has been allocated for Autumn term to supplement learning support materials and equipment, and subsidise school trips and clubs. The same amount will be allocated to Winter and Summer terms. Annual Accounts and an Annual Report have been formally approved by trustees and submitted to the Charity Commission.
