

Re: Year 5 Trips

Dear Parents / Guardians,

We have two exciting trips coming up in September. The first is a visit to Lancaster University to see 'Massive Wagons Primary School Show' on Friday 19th September. After registering our interest earlier this year we were lucky enough to be successful and are one of 11 schools attending this event! We will be leaving school at approximately 9:45am and returning to school at approximately 11:45am in time for lunch and travelling by public transport.

Our second trip is to Helmshore Mill in Rossendale. This is a Victorian Textile Museum which links to our learning in History this term where we are learning about the Victorian Era, with a focus on what working life was like for the Victorians in the mills. The children have already shown a keen interest in this topic and are looking forward to learning more about this era.

Throughout the day we will be taking part in two workshops, The Cotton Story and Revolution at Work and at Home, where the children will be able to experience working and living conditions. As this is a full day trip, we will be leaving school at around 8:45am to arrive promptly for our 10am start. The workshops will finish at 2:30pm and our return back to school will be at approximately 3:45pm, meaning that our end of the day time will be later than normal.
