Dear Parent/Carer,

We are very excited to let you know that we will be taking Year 4 to the World Museum in Liverpool.

This will support the children's learning in history, particularly their topic on Ancient Egypt. The visit will give pupils the opportunity to explore real Egyptian artefacts, including mummies and historical objects, helping to bring their classroom learning to life. By experiencing these exhibits first-hand, children will deepen their understanding of Ancient Egyptian civilisation, including beliefs, daily life, and the importance of archaeology in learning about the past. This trip will provide an engaging and memorable experience that will enrich their knowledge and inspire curiosity.

The total cost of the trip will be £13.40 per child, which will cover transport. We ask for this as a voluntary contribution. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may not be able to go ahead.

However, if your child is either on free school meals, an armed forces service child or a looked after child school will pay for this trip from the PPG budget unless you are willing and able to meet this contribution. For PPG children, please confirm in your child's communication diary if you wish school to pay for this, as this will also act as permission for them to attend the trip.

- Date: Tuesday 30th June 2026
- Time: Leaving school at 8.45am prompt – please ensure your child arrives on time
- Return to school: prior to 3.10pm
- Cost: £13.40 – (payable via ParentPay by Friday 26th June)
- Clothing: Full school uniform with a coat
- Lunches: Packed lunch and a drink to be provided in a disposable bag. If your child is on free school meals, school will provide a packed lunch for this trip. Please write in your child's communication diary by Thursday 21st May if you will be providing a packed lunch from home on his day.
